

## Driver Education General Information

### ***Obtaining the CDE Form***

The CDE Form is now available under the Required Documents section of the student's online account. If you need the CDE Form mailed, please email us at [info@driverightinc.com](mailto:info@driverightinc.com).

### ***Scheduling the 6-hours of Instructional Drive Time***

Once the online coursework is 100% complete and the student has obtained their permit, you can schedule your 6 hours of Instructional Drive Time. To schedule your drive times, you will need to email us at [info@driverightinc.com](mailto:info@driverightinc.com) to obtain instructor contact information or a link to an instructor's online calendar.

Drive times fill up fast, so don't wait! A guide to assist you in scheduling the drive times is as follows *(based on the Supervised Driving Log)*:

- 0-20 hours: 1 instructional hour per week
- 21-40 hours: 2 instructional hours per week
- 41+ hours: 3 instructional hours per week

Please note that this is only a guide, and the driving instructor has the final decision over their schedule and how they schedule students.

### ***Driving Skills Exam***

Since you have completed the online coursework and the 6 hours of Instructional Drive Time, you can take the BMV Driving Skills Exam through our Company rather than through the BMV. Please note that this does not change the student's actual eligibility date. An additional fee of \$50.00 is payable on the day of the Driving Skills Exam. A few benefits of going through our Company for the Driving Skills Exam:

- *Can be done anytime after the 6<sup>th</sup> instructional drive time vs. waiting until the student's true eligibility date to take it at the BMV.*
- *Have the same instructor and car you completed 6 hours in vs. your vehicle and a BMV Service Representative riding in the passenger seat (reflective vest and clipboard).*

### ***License Eligibility Date***

When you obtained your permit, the BMV should have written your eligibility date at the top of the 50-hour Supervised Driving Log. If they did not, or you believe it to be in error, please refer to the following information to determine your true eligibility date.

- 16 years and 90 days of age, and must have held the permit for 180 days
- For an on-time eligibility date, the student should get their permit 90 days before their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday.
